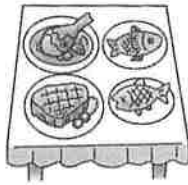

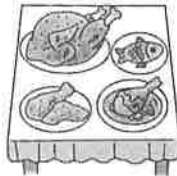

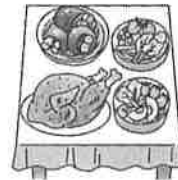

When you go to the US, one of your American friends treats you to a great meal. When a waiter sends the bill to the table, your friend takes out money to pay the bill. When you are going to leave the restaurant, you find your friend left some money on the table. You pick up the money and remind your friend of it, but your friend asks you to put it back on the table. Of course, you have to do so because it is the tip for the waiter. It is one of the ways to show respect to service workers in the US.

Tipping is not very common in most parts of the world, but it is necessary at restaurants in the US because waiters are paid poorly. In other words, waiters often need to make a living from tips. In order to get more tips, they try their best to give you greater service. How much you tip waiters means how happy you feel about the service.

Before you give a tip to a waiter, you have to think about the dining time and the number of people at the table. Most of the time, Americans tip 10% of the bill for lunch, and 15% for dinner. However, for a group of five or more, Americans tip 15% of the bill for lunch, and 20% for dinner. It is because waiters need to do more when there are more people at a table. Of course, if you feel great about the service, you can leave more tips.
