When living or traveling in a foreign country, you may see some cultural differences. It's always a good idea to understand these differences to avoid doing or saying something wrong.

Some misunderstandings happen because of the way people use the language. For example, in Taiwan and Japan, people are taught to be humble when they talk about themselves. However, in the United States, it's common for a person to show off his or her abilities in order to get noticed. So, if you're interviewed to get a job in the States, tell them what you can do as much as possible.

In Eastern Asia, it is common not to make eye contact with someone while speaking to him or her. However, to a Westerner, doing this could make you look like the person who is always lying. Also, the use of gestures can also cause misunderstandings. The thumbs-up sign means "well done" in the West but can be impolite in parts of the Middle East. In the West, putting your middle finger up is very rude, but in Vietnam, the middle finger is often used to point at things. Different countries have different culture, so just respect and follow them when you are there. As the old saying goes, "When in Rome, do as the Romans do."
