The US Postal Service (USPS) provides people with a great service. It gets and delivers their mails at a low cost. When it began on 1792, people could only send letters. Then, in 1913, the USPS started its Parcel Post service. In this way, people could send and receive packages. However, the rules about the packages weren't very clear. So, some people took the advantage of that to mail their kids.

The first was an Ohio couple. The Beagles mailed their 8-month-old son to his grandmother. Luckily, she only lived not far, just a mile away.

The most famous case happened in Idaho in 1914. Five-year-old May Pierstorff's parents sent her 73 miles to her grandma's house by railway mail. It was cheaper than a ticket. May's parents put stamps on her coat and gave her to the mail carrier. He just happened to be May's mother's cousin. He kept her company on the train and delivered her to her grandma.

Finally, in 1920, the USPS put an end to mailing kids. It's a good thing, too. Just imagine that travel would be like today.
